## FY 2013 Development Activities

## FY 2013 Highlights

- Overall contributions were flat (-0.3\%) compared to FY 2012
- The Sigma Xi Fund increased 9\% from FY 2012
- Estate gifts grew in number and value over FY 2012
- GIAR contributions grew 41\% over FY 2012
- We received a pledge of $\$ 100,000$ from DIRECTV to sponsor the Ingenuity:

The Journal of Student Engineering and Science Research

o Promoted members are excellent donors (by member grade)
o Emeritus members are our largest group of donors (by member type)
o 56\% of our donors in FY 2012 also gave (\$10 or more) in FY 2013
