FY 2013 Highlights

- Overall contributions were flat (-0.3%) compared to FY 2012
- The Sigma Xi Fund increased 9% from FY 2012
- Estate gifts grew in number and value over FY 2012
- GIAR contributions grew 41% over FY 2012
- We received a pledge of \$100,000 from DIRECTV to sponsor the *Ingenuity:* The Journal of Student Engineering and Science Research
- Several characteristics popped up when looking at our member donor base:
 - Promoted members are excellent donors (by member grade)
 - Emeritus members are our largest group of donors (by member type)
 - o 56% of our donors in FY 2012 also gave (\$10 or more) in FY 2013







FY 2013 Contributions by Members - By Dues Category








