Sigma Xi, The Scientific Research Society invites nominations for the prestigious Monie A. Ferst Award, which honors researchers in science and engineering who have made notable contributions to the motivation and encouragement of research through education.

Sponsored by the Georgia Tech Chapter of Sigma Xi, this national award consists of a medal and \$10,000.



In addition, a day-long symposium is held in the fall semester each year at Georgia Tech to highlight the achievements of the winner's former students, postdocs, and other significant mentees. Travel, lodging, and meal expenses of the winner and symposium presenters are also covered as part of the award.
