SIGMA XI, THE SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH SOCIETY Report of the Committee on Grants in Aid of Research For the Year Ending 30 June 2019

The Sigma Xi Grants in Aid of Research Program is now in its ninety-seventh year. The Committee held two meetings during fiscal year 2019. During the meetings, the Committee reviewed a total of 1,935 applications, of which 247 (13%) received full or partial funding. A total of \$233,430 was awarded. This represents a 9% increase in the number of submitted applications from the prior year and a 7% decrease in the number of applications funded. The committee attempts to stretch available resources to benefit as many students as possible.

The accompanying table shows the distribution of applications, awards, and funds among the science and engineering disciplines. The names of the recipients and their institutions are listed on the Sigma Xi web site.

Support from members and interest income from the Society's research endowment continues to be an essential component of the GIAR program. Designated funds from the National Academy of Sciences, which are administered by Sigma Xi, provide valuable additional resources for the program and accounted for 48% of funds awarded.
