SIGMA XI, THE SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH SOCIETY Report of the Committee on Grants in Aid of Research For the Year Ending 30 June 2020

The Sigma Xi Grants in Aid of Research Program is now in its 98th year. The Committee held two meetings during fiscal year 2020. During the meetings, the Committee reviewed a total of 1,654 applications, of which 205 (12%) received full or partial funding. A total of \$228,367 was awarded. This represents a 8% decrease in the number of submitted applications from the prior year and a 8% decrease in the number of applications funded. The committee attempts to stretch available resources to benefit as many students as possible.

The accompanying table shows the distribution of applications, awards, and funds among the science and engineering disciplines. The names of the recipients and their institutions are listed on the Sigma Xi web site.

Support from members and interest income from the Society's research endowment continues to be an essential component of the GIAR program. Designated funds from the National Academy of Sciences, which are administered by Sigma Xi, provide valuable additional resources for the program and accounted for 38% of funds awarded. In addition, funds were received from the San Antonio Lighthouse for the Blind and Vision Impaired to fund students conducting vision-related research or identify as being visually impaired.
